## Insurance Cost

Eligibility Status	Responsibility for Program Payment
Eligible for Medicare and Medicaid	Medicare and Medicaid pays for the program
Eligible for only Medicare	Participant pays only the Medicaid portion plus Part D
Eligible for only Medicaid	Medicaid pays for the program
Not eligible for Medicare or Medicaid	Participant pays self-pay rate

There are no co-pays, deductibles or hidden fees of any kind, even prescribed medication from your PACE Care Team is covered.

PACE Place participants receive all needed health care services, including primary care and specialist(s) services (other than emergency services), from PACE Place or a provider authorized by PACE Place. A participant may be fully and personally liable for the costs of unauthorized or out-of-PACE Place program network services.
