PACE Place is for Caregivers

PACE Place Eligibility Criteria

- Adults 55 and older
- Live in an approved service area
- Meet the nursing home level of care requirements as determined by the State of Florida
- Able to live safely at home or in the community with PACE Place support at the time of enrollment

PACE Place participants receive all needed health care services, including primary care and specialist(s) services (other than emergency services), from PACE Place or a provider authorized by PACE Place. A participant may be fully and personally liable for the costs of unauthorized or out-of-PACE Place program network services.

With the PACE Place Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly, getting older doesn't mean losing your independence. Our participants live full and meaningful lives – and often say they have never been as active or satisfied.
